Youth Advisory Board Objectives

- 1. Cultivate an authentic youth voice to ensure that the perspectives, experiences, and ideas of young people are heard, valued, and integrated into the decision-making process
- 2. Create opportunities for youth to explore and engage in community services, resources, and employment
- 3. Develop personal and professional skills to assist in future career paths
- 4. Receive mentorship
- 5. Empower youth to grow as leaders

November 14, 2024 from 5:00pm – 7:00pm was selected for the next meeting. The meeting will be held at the Camden County OEO Urban Woman's Center, 900 Broadway, Camden, NJ 08103.

- The committee is looking for more participants.

 - Emphasize volunteer hours to students furthering their education and leadership experience.
- Stipends will not be given due to funding.

- The Youth Focus group will meet 4 to 6 meetings per year, the targeted age is 16-24 years of age.

Youth One Stop Update

Jyi Peterson reports for the month of September at the Youth One Stop, there were 37 youth at Orientation, 9 in Remediation (formerly the Learning Link) and 5 contracts for In Demand Occupational Training and 5 youth finished school and received employment.
